The Oracle House name, brand and ministry remains valid and active, but the *church* arm of the ministry becomes *The Quarry* or *The Quarry Church*.

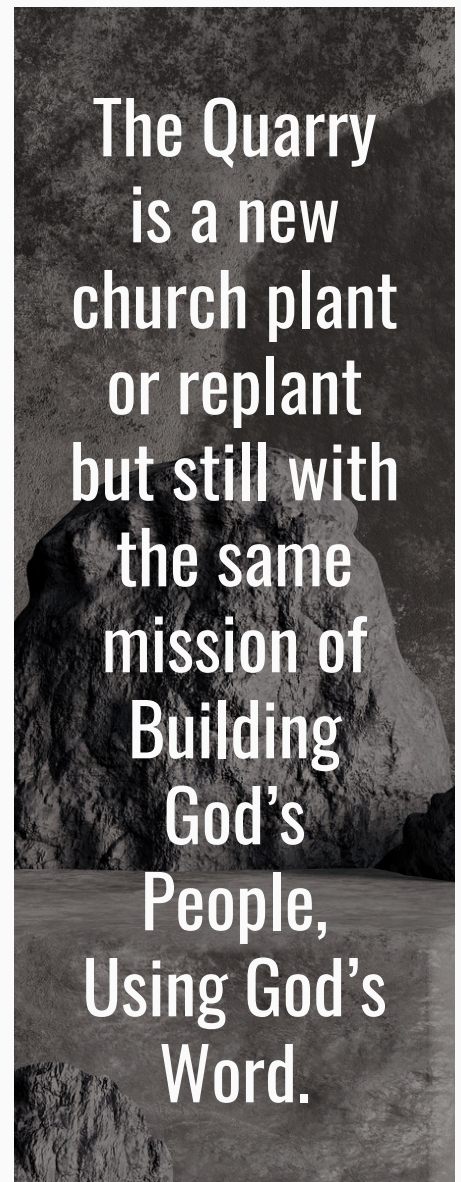
